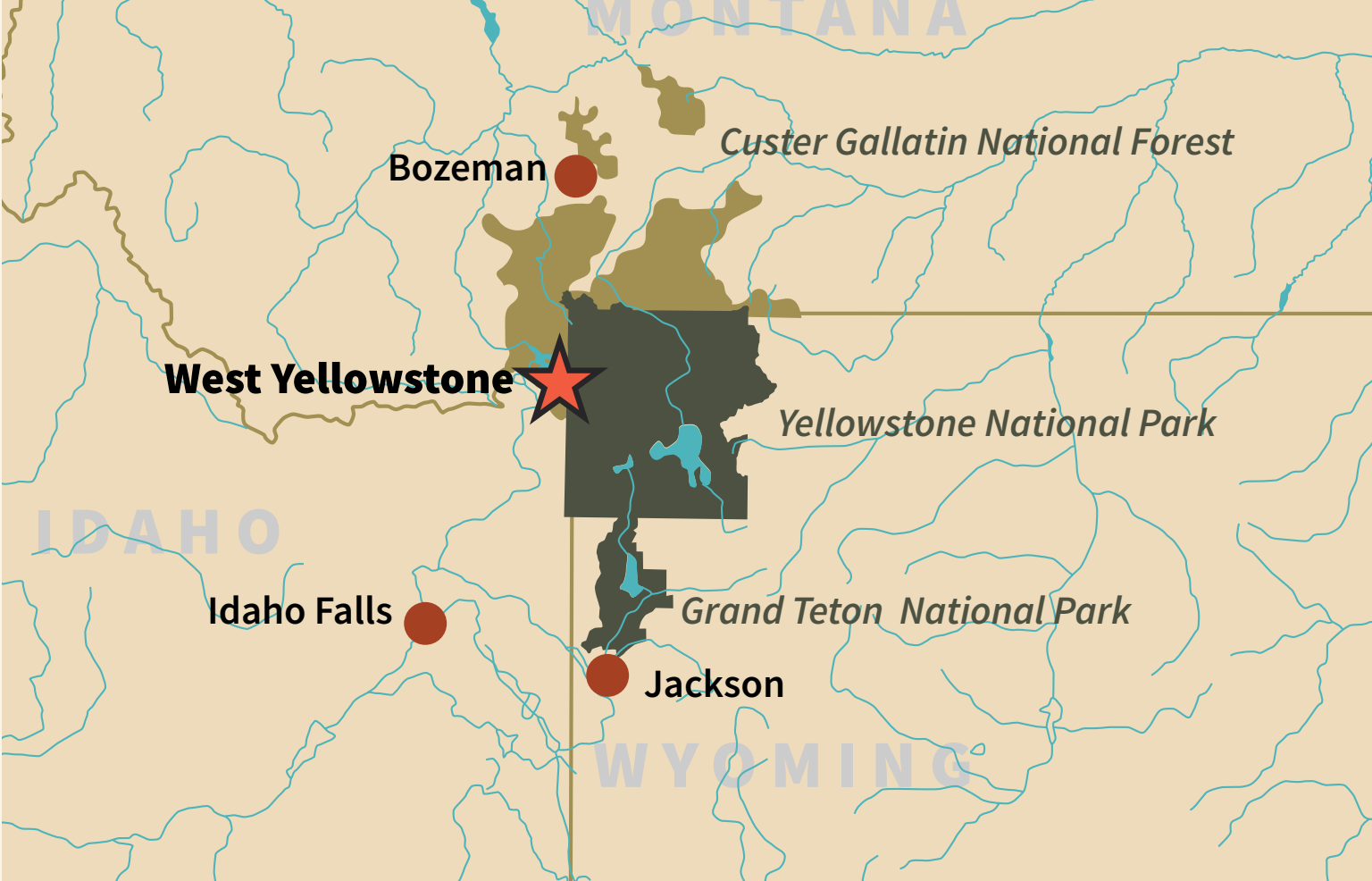

Here's a sample itinerary to get you started on your planning for whichever path you pick.

WINTER

DAY ONE

Stop by the **Yellowstone Trapper's Restaurant** for a hot breakfast to get the day started

Hop in a snowcoach from **Back Country Adventures** for a guided tour into Yellowstone National Park

Head back into town after your tour and get your skates for some skating at the local rink

Finish your day with dinner at the **Three Bear Lodge & Restaurant**, which is full of not only excellent meals but also tons of Yellowstone décor and memorabilia to enjoy while you eat.

DAY TWO
