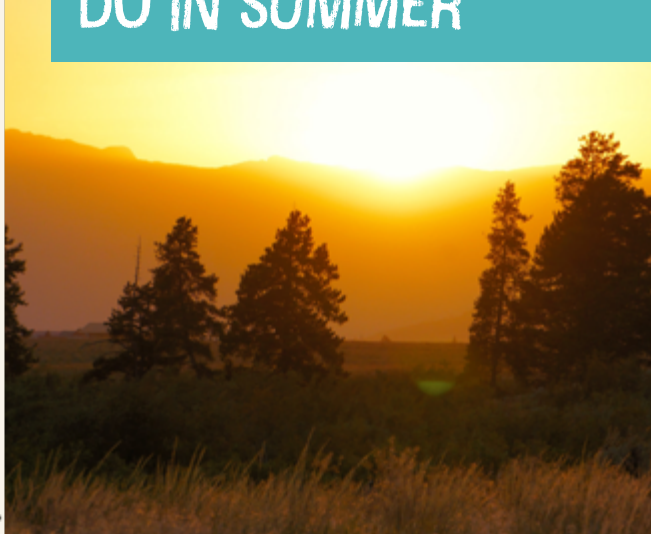
PICK YOUR PATH

2. Float down the river on a raft or kayak
3. Take a private horseback riding tour through the mountains

HOOKED YET?

Here's a sample itinerary to get you started on your planning for whichever path you pick.

WINTER

DAY ONE

Enjoy breakfast at the **Book Peddler**, a charming bookstore that also serves as a café with coffee, pastries, breakfast burritos, and more specialties.

After your meal, spend some time strolling the surrounding streets shopping, where you can pick out the perfect memorabilia from your trip.

While you're in town, stop by our **community ice rink** and take a few turns surrounded by the beautiful winter snow.

Grab a bite to eat at the **Buffalo Bar and Casino** for lunch, a homey tavern with rustic décor and delicious bar bites.

Get back into the wild, this time in snowshoes! The western corridor of Yellowstone National Park and nearby forests offer multiple trails, including the **Riverside Trail**.

After a day of exploring the wilderness, enjoy the **best pizza in the Rockies** at **Wild West Pizzeria and Saloon** for dinner. The Saloon is the perfect place to relax after a long day in Yellowstone, with fresh ingredients in every dish and fantastic live entertainment.

At the end of the day, stoke up a fire and cozy up in your own personal cabin. There are many options right in West Yellowstone, including **Bar N Ranch**, **Blue Cloud Cabins**, **Cabins West**, **Explorer Cabins**, and more.

DAY TWO

Get the pick-me-up you need at **Mountain Mama's Coffee House and Bakery** before heading out to the slopes!

We highly encourage you to spend at least part of your day on the area's famous ski trails. **There are over 50 kilometers of groomed trails accessible from the edge of West Yellowstone.** The town is also close to some downhill skiing at **Bridger Bowl**, **Big Sky Resort**, and **Targhee**.

After skiing, grab a bite for lunch at the **Slippery Otter Pub & Eatery** and don't forget to try one of their regional beers! If you're feeling adventurous, they also have some of the best burgers in Montana – including bison, elk, lamb, and veggie burger options.

When the sun starts to set, travel to **Big Sky** to take a romantic sleigh ride through the freshly fallen snow.

End your day with dinner at **Bullwinkle's**, which offers a full dinner, dessert, and bar menu. Bonus: after dinner, you can enjoy their expansive local liquor shop and casino!

SUMMER

DAY ONE

Start your day with freshly baked breads and pastries at **Ernie's Bakery and Deli**. While you're at it, grab one of their to-go lunches!

Hike into **Custer Gallatin National Forest** and stop for a romantic picnic for two along the way.

After a busy morning, spend the afternoon floating through the waters in a two-person kayak in and around Yellowstone.

For dinner, treat yourselves to a fine dining experience at **Madison Crossing Lounge**. From house-made pasta to flat iron steak and an array of craft cocktails, you'll both find something you love.

At the end of the night, head to **The Adventure Inn Yellowstone**. This luxuriously rustic inn will charm you with its warmth and romantic atmosphere, and is mere blocks from the entrance to Yellowstone National Park.

DAY TWO

Wake up and enjoy sweet treats and delectable drinks for breakfast at **Mocha Mamma's** at Free Heel and Wheel.

Head to one of our nearby ranches and enjoy a private guided horseback tour into the mountains of the area.

Stop by the **Canyon Street Grill** for lunch, a 50s themed diner where everything is hot and made to order.

In the afternoon, rent some bikes and head into one of the many trails surrounding West Yellowstone, including the **Continental Divide Trail**, and the **TransAmerica Trail**. Once you've found a nice spot, take a break and watch the sunset together.

Enjoy an evening meal at West Yellowstone's must-try **Three Bear Lodge & Restaurant**, which offers excellent food and plentiful Yellowstone memorabilia.
