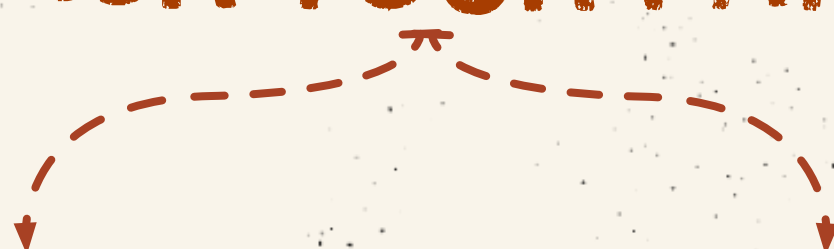

SUMMER

Fishing

Cast a line at Hebgen Lake where you'll be hooked on the rainbow, brown, and cutthroat trout catches averaging 15-20 inches

Bird watching

With over 300 species in the area, sparrows, soras, yellow-rumped warblers, and mountain bluebirds are just the tip of the peak.

Rodeos

Hit the Wild West Yellowstone rodeo, where an authentic fun-for-all-ages show is complete with cowboys, riding, and ropes.

Horseback Rides

Saddle up for a guided horseback adventure that will help you slow down and fully connect with your surroundings.

WINTER

Snowshoe

Strap on your snowshoes and explore the wilderness in and around West Yellowstone

Ice fishing

Gather your gear and head to Hebgen Lake for an unforgettable ice fishing experience. If you feel in over your head, local fly shops and seasoned experts can help guide your line.

Frozen waterfalls
