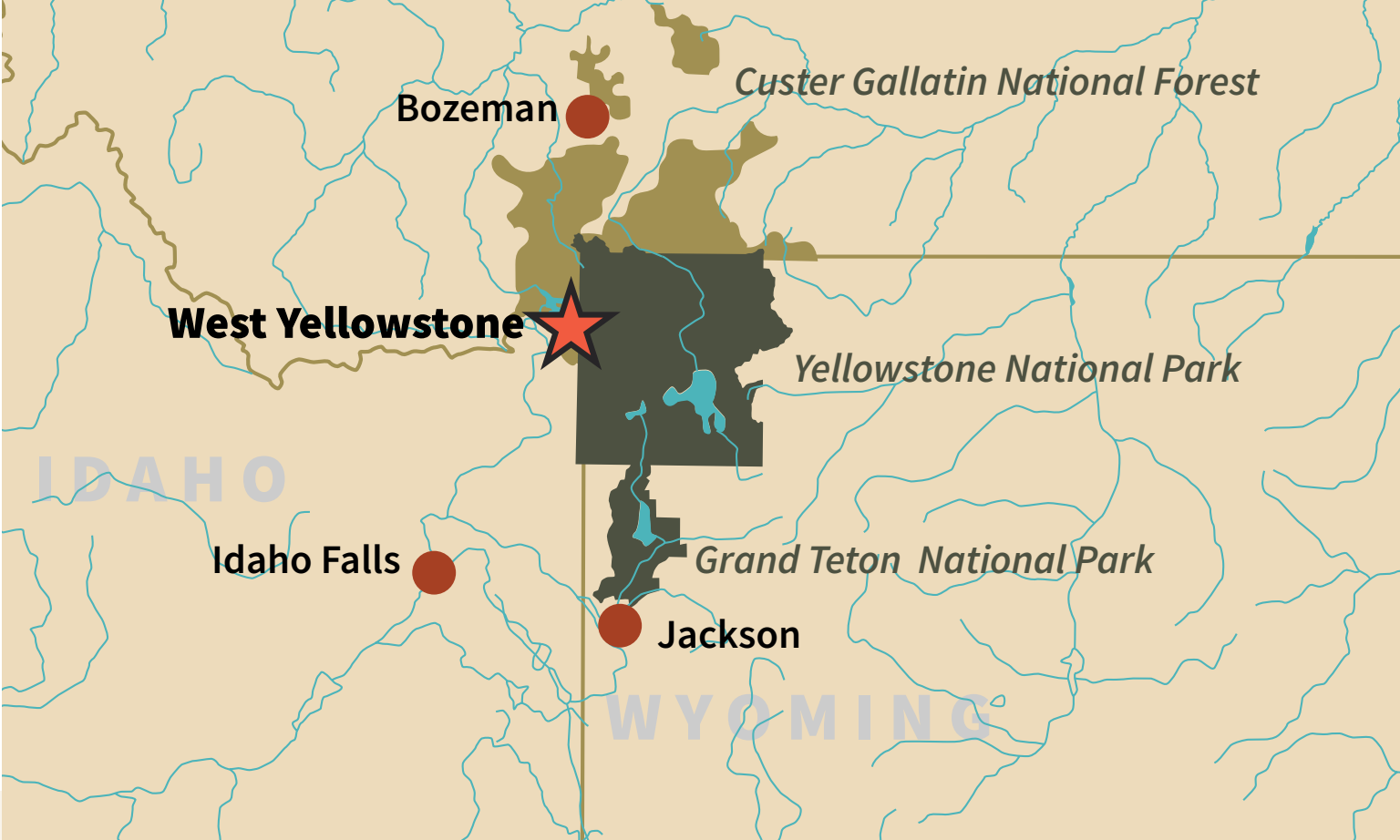

WINTER

DAY ONE

Enjoy sweet treats and delectable drinks for breakfast at **Mocha Mamma's** at Free Heel and Wheel.

Enjoy the unique experience of journeying through nature on a dogsled! If you're lucky, you may also be able to catch West Yellowstone's famous annual dogsled race.

Grab a bite for lunch at the **Slippery Otter Pub & Eatery**, and don't forget to try their jalapeño wontons with huckleberry dipping sauce, or one of their regional beers! If you're feeling adventurous, they also have some of the best burgers in Montana – including bison, elk, lamb, and veggie burger options.

Get back out there in the wild, this time in snowshoes! The western corridor of Yellowstone National Park and nearby forests offer multiple trails, including the **Riverside Trail**.

After a day of exploring the wilderness, treat yourselves to a fine dining experience at **Madison Crossing Lounge**. From house-made pasta to flat iron steak and an array of craft cocktails, there's something for everyone in the group to enjoy.

Experience more than a place to sleep by staying at **West Yellowstone's Bar N Ranch**. With options from spacious lodge rooms or entire cabins to yourself, enjoy the rustic charm and expansive amenities available.

DAY TWO

Start your day with freshly baked goods and hearty breakfast burritos at the **Book Peddler**.

Spend the first part of your day on the area's famous ski trails. There's over 50km of groomed Nordic ski trails accessible from the edge of West Yellowstone. The town is also close to some downhill skiing at **Bridger Bowl, Big Sky Resort, and Targhee**.

Stop by the **Buffalo Bar and Casino** for lunch and enjoy delicious bites and fun games.

For a more relaxed afternoon, consider going out to **Hebgen Lake** for its iconic ice fishing.

Enjoy the best pizza in the Rockies at **Wild West Pizzeria and Saloon** for dinner. The Saloon is the perfect place to relax with friends after a long day in Yellowstone, with fresh ingredients in every dish and fantastic live entertainment.

SUMMER

DAY ONE

Wake up early for a fresh coffee and hot meal at **Mountain Mama's Cafe & Bakery** before heading half a block over to the Boundary Trail for a hike along the border of **Yellowstone National Park**.

Stop for lunch at the best barbeque joint in town. **Firehole BBQ** is locally run and offers brisket, ribs, and more. Or, take it to go and have a picnic in nearby **Custer Gallatin National Forest**!

Cool off from the afternoon heat at **Hebgen Lake** for fishing, paddle boarding, or boating.

After a long day of fun, stop by the **Buffalo Bar and Casino** for delicious bar bites and fun events like trivia.

Rest your head in the adult-exclusive **1872 inn**. Open only in summer, this inn offers stylish accommodations and an authentic Montana experience.

DAY TWO

Gear up for a busy day with hearty pancakes and mouth-watering chicken fried steak at the **Running Bear Pancake House**.

Use your first stop to visit animals like bears, wolves, and more up close and personal at the **Grizzly & Wolf Discovery Center**.

If you're seeking even more thrills, take flight on a zipline at **Yellowstone Aerial Adventures**.

Take a break and enjoy some of **Timberline Café's** famous homemade pie.

In the afternoon, explore the mountains around West Yellowstone on one of our guided horseback tours. Whether you're a beginner or advanced rider, there are options for everyone in the group. They even have overnight trips for the extra adventurous types.

End your day with dinner at **Bullwinkle's**, which offers a full dinner, dessert, and bar menu. Bonus: after dinner, you can enjoy their expansive local liquor shop and casino!
